
N O T I F I C A T I O N

The State Government has set up the State Forensic Science Laboratory (SFSL) at Narsingarh, West Tripura District under the direct control of the Home Department. The Document Divisions is now equipped to start the examination of document cases in the Laboratory. The Director General of Police is requested to inform all Superintendents of Police and Officers in Charge of all Police Stations of the State to send documents seized in different crime cases to SFSL with effect from the date of issue of the Notification. The case exhibits are forwarded to the Laboratory for examination as done in other cases.

The nature of exhibits to be examined in Document Division are:

- (i) Examination of different disputed documents including Fake Indian Currency Notes (FICN) and foreign Currency Notes.
- (ii) Eraser/alteration of document by chemical/or mechanical.
- (iii) Simple forgery (comparison of signature/writing).
- (iv) Type written documents & their comparison.
- (v) Disputed Bank cheque/draft/lottery ticket etc.
